

## **Cabot Recreation Committee Meeting Minutes**

Thursday, May 20, 2021

Stef Burtt called the meeting to order at 6:12 p.m. and Shannon seconded the motion.

The agenda was approved.

The previous meeting minutes were approved.

Stef gave an update on the skating equipment. It was successfully moved to the Recycling Center for storage over the summer.

Jess North gave an update on the summer camps, they are as follows:

- Jess met with Silas Robbins about the mountain biking camp. It is to be held June 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. The time is to be determined once people reach out to sign-up their child(ren). A fee of \$20 was agreed upon.
- Jess talked to Brody Moran about a soccer camp. He will need an adult to help chaperone.
- Jess emailed Karen Muller-Harder about a theater camp. Karen wondered what the COVID protocol was.
- Jess and Cam talked about a basketball camp in August and started to brainstorm possible dates, with the first week in August being a possibility. Cam mentioned needing another coach to volunteer as the grades to be offered range from 3-8.
- Fees for the other summer camps will be decided upon once more planning/finalizing has taken place.

The summer events were then talked about:

- The June 9<sup>th</sup> community corn hole/volleyball event date was moved to June 8<sup>th</sup> instead as to avoid any conflicts with Highschool graduation. It will be held from 5-7 p.m. There will need to be a few volunteers to come early to help set-up the volleyball nets.
- The High Schoolers would like to have a Field Day. It would be another opportunity for them to complete community service. It was mentioned by Stef that community pick-up kick ball games could be fun too. Olivia Smith was going to check to see if the corn hole boards at the school were available to be borrowed/used. Shannon wondered how many adults would need to be present to help the high schoolers?
- A possible event in August was mentioned as a way to showcase the pavilion and promote it to be rented.

- Stef gave an update on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. The town will not hold the parade as to adhere to COVID regulations, but wants to do something. The Rec. Committee might still be able to do something, like games etc. at the pavilion. The bouncy house was mentioned as an option.

Shannon mentioned that her husband, Eric Smith, would be willing to volunteer to help with the set-up/maintenance of the skating rink.

Stef mentioned that she checked with Betty Ritter about the pavilion rental and Betty was going to reach out to the select board.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:07p.m., Brandy seconded the motion.
